

Moving with Pets Checklist

Bringing your dogs and cats into Mexico calmly

Before travel (US vet)

- ☐ Health check within 15 days of travel (keep the record)
- ☐ Rabies vaccination certificate (over 3 months old pets)
- ☐ Internal & external parasite treatment noted by your vet
- ☐ No official USDA health certificate needed for dogs/cats by land — but carry vet records

At the border / airport (SENASICA check)

- ☐ Pets are inspected by SENASICA — have records handy
- ☐ Clean carrier with no bedding/toys made of organic material
- ☐ Only pet food allowed: sealed bag, day's ration

Settling in Mexico

- ☐ Find an English-friendly vet in your destination city
- ☐ Update microchip registration with your Mexican address
- ☐ Plan for heat: walks early/late, never leave pets in cars
